

GUIDELINE FEES FOR OH ELECTIVE SERVICES 2018

Please note: the prices listed for travel vaccinations and blood tests are determined by the costs charged to the Medical Centre by outside organisations, and although we work hard to negotiate student discounts, this is not always possible. We have no control of the prices we are charged for vaccines, blood tests etc. If the prices rise, the charges will go up but we do our best to negotiate lower prices.

Anti-malarial tablets

These will need to be purchased from an independent pharmacy. Prices vary considerably according to which anti-malarial is recommended and where they are bought.

HIV PEP (starter pack)

These drugs are expensive. It is therefore in your interest to seek clarification from your host institution as to the availability of HIV PEP. They are specially made up starter packs and we have a specific arrangement with UEA Boots Pharmacy (on campus) to make these. We have been informed they cost in the region of £210 and can take approximately one week to obtain.
